सर्व संबंधित छात्र/छात्राओं को सूचित किया जाता है कि इस विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा मध्यप्रदेश विश्वविद्यालय अधिनियम 1973 की धारा (1) 4 के अंतर्गत महामहिम भूतपूर्व राष्ट्रपति डॉ० शंकरदयाल शर्मा, राष्ट्रपति सचिवालय, राष्ट्रपति भवन, नई दिल्ली द्वारा प्रायोजित जीवाजी विश्वविद्यालय के एक छात्र/छात्रा उसकी सर्वांगीण दक्षता के आधार पर सत्र 1995-96 से प्रतिवर्ष एक स्वर्ण-पदक भारत के राष्ट्रपति डॉ० शंकरदयाल शर्मा "स्वर्ण-पदक" स्थापित किया है। सर्वांगीण दक्षता से आशय छात्र का चरित्र आचरण/व्यवहार शैक्षणिक गतिविधियों में उत्कृष्टता अन्य व्यवहारिक गतिविधियों तथा समाज सेवा सम्मिलित है।

इस स्वर्ण-पदक हेतु योग्य छात्र/छात्रा के चुनाव के लिये जिन छात्र/छात्रा ने स्नातकोत्तर कक्षाओं की सत्र 2020-21 की प्रावीण्य सूची में स्थान प्राप्त किया है उन छात्र/छात्राओं से सादे कागज पर पूर्ण विवरण एवं प्रमाण-पत्रों (शैक्षणिक, क्रीड़ा एवं सांस्कृतिक) सहित आवेदन पत्र दिनांक. 16/08/2022 तक आमंत्रित किये जाते हैं।

GOLD MEDAL

( u/s 26 (1) (iv) of the Act )

- 1- The medal has been instituted by the generous endowment made by the President of India , Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma.
- 2- The name of the award shall be "The President of India, Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma Gold Medal". It shall be inscribed on a 15-20g silver medal plate with 500-600mg of gold.
- 3- The medal shall be awarded to the student adjudged the best for General Proficiency adjudged on the basis of his character, conduct, excellence in academic performance, extra curricular activities and social services.
- 4- The Medal shall be awarded to the student at the convocation and/or a special function organized as per decision of the Executive Council.
- 5- The award shall be given to a post-graduate student having continuous good academic record together with his performances in extra curricular activities and social service.
- 6- The selection of the award shall be made in the following manner :-
  - (i) The biodate on prescribed form shall be obtained from all the students who figure in the merit-list of Post-graduate examination of the year for which the award has to be given.
  - (ii) The merit of the candidate shall be determined by preparation of an index in the manner described for each of the following two categories :-
    - (a) Candidates appearing in merit who have noteworthy contributions in extra curricular activities and social service.
    - (b) Candidates appearing the merit who have noteworthy contribution in either the extracurricular activities and social service.
  - (iii) The candidates falling in category 'A' shall be first considered for the award of the medal. The candidates falling under category 'b' shall be considered only when candidates under category 'A' are not available or not found to be suitable.
- 7-  The merit of the candidate shall be determined by preparing an index in the following manner:-
  - (i) Academic excellence

The merit Holders at Master degree level having First class at all the public examinations i.e. High school, plus two degree examination and post graduate examination or higher secondary degree and post graduate examinations with no break in carrier shall be considered. In order to incorporate the weightage of academic Excellence average percentage of marks obtained in all the public examinations shall be determined.
  - (ii) Extracurricular activities:

The Candidates taking part and getting distinctions in the sports, debates, dance, drama, music etc. shall be awarded following index numbers for each of the activities separately and sum total of these shall be taken to compute final index.

7	For acquiring apposition in All India level competitions.
5	For participation in All India level competitions.
4	For acquiring a position in State/Inter University competitions.
3	For participation at State/Inter University competitions.
2	Position at University/District level competitions.
1	Participation at University/District Level competition.

Note:- N.C.C. Participation shall also be considered in the like manner.

(iii) Social service

Candidates involved in social service shall also be awarded indices as follows:-

7	Certificate for social service at all India level by a recognized all India organization.
5	'C' Certificate of N.S.S. and/or certificate for social service at regional level by a recognized body.
3	'B' certificate of N.S.S. and/or a certificate for Social work at local level.

(iv) A consolidated index by adding the scores of subsection (i) (ii) and (iii) shall be prepared for each category of the candidates as per section 6 of the rule.

8- The Registrar shall send the biodata sheet to the candidates figuring in merit of the post-graduate examination soon after the publication of merit list and get the index prepared.

9- The index shall be prepared by a committee of three Deans of Faculty appointed by the Kulapati for the purpose and the recommendation of the committee shall be pleased before the Executive council for final award of the president of India, "R. Shankar Dayal Sharma, Gold Medal."
