 - a) Senior Medical Officer – Monthly payment-Rs. 50, 000/- per month (Consolidated)
Eligibility: PG (any branch of Ayurveda, with specialization/proven experience in Panchakarma/Community medicine)
 - b) Junior Medical Officer: Monthly payment-Rs. 25, 000/- per month (Consolidated)
Eligibility: BAMS with experience in blood analysis/ M.Sc in Biochemistry/ Microbiology/Life Sciences experience in assessment of physiological and biochemical parameters using semi auto/autoanalyzers, compilation of data in excell and other formats, statistical analysis of data, Assisting SMO in preparation of project reports and all other matters.
 - c) Laboratory investigator-1 No.: M.Sc Biochemistry or allied subject with experience in blood laboratory investigations and data compilation and analysis
4. The selected candidates should be prepared to reach field/villages early hours as per the demand of the project work.
5. The Medical officers will be responsible for all kinds of work related to PHI project viz., making arrangements for OPDs in and out, field visits, data compilation, analysis, preparation and maintenance of daily, weekly, Monthly, quarterly, six monthly and annual reports and records.
6. The Panchakarma technicians would assist in panchakarma therapies of patients and would assist Physicians and Principal Investigator in conducting field camps, sampling and sample analysis and data management.
7. The biomedical person with degree in Biochemistry/allied subject would assist in conducting laboratory analyses and help physicians in conducting field camps.
8. The positions are co-terminus with the project and may be discontinued by principal investigator at any time during the course of project work if the performance is unsatisfactory.
