

National Conference on “Recent Trends in R & D, Quality Control and Marketing in Chemical Industries” and Alumni Meet

April 23– 25, 2016 at Jiwaji University, Gwalior

A National Conference on ‘Recent Trends in R & D, Quality Control and Marketing in Chemical Industries’ and Alumni Meet was organized between April 23-25th 2016 by the Department of Industrial Chemistry and Chemical Sales & Marketing Management, Jiwaji University, Gwalior. The conference was sponsored by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and M.P. Council of Science & Technology, (MPCST), Bhopal.

The conference was inaugurated on 23rd by Hon’ble Vice Chancellor in presence of Hon’ble Rector and other invited dignitaries.
