 Representative democracy

Representative democracy – A government in which the people vote for (elect) a smaller group of citizens who make the rules and laws for everyone.

Advantages of Representative Democracy

 Represent Diverse groups – More likely that all elements of the population are represented.

 Voice of people Heard –Citizens are involved in decision making through their representatives, lobbying, and voting.
