		Emergency is the creature of necessity, of unforeseen situations critics. It is very difficult to define emergency in exact terms. In

original and primary sense, it is defined as the act of emergency. The term "emergency" connotes "sudden occurrence or exigency, implying imminent danger, which leaves no time for deliberations, or a sudden or unexpected necessity requiring speedy action, although the word does not always or necessarily imply suddenness or unforeseableness, or a temporary condition, for it, may also comprehend a pressing necessity or exigency, not necessarily wholly unexpected." It has also been defined as the power granted to or used or acquired by a public authority to meet exigencies of a particular emergency (as of war or disaster) whether within or outside a constitutional frame of reference. In the present context, the term "emergency" has been expanded to cover any situation which is deemed dangerous to the welfare of the people.
