# P.G. DIPLOMA IN INSTRUMENTATION AND COMMENT IAL METHODS IN INDUSTRIAL ANALYSIS

The course for the P.G. Diploma will be divided into two semesters covering one academic session only. Each semester normally comprise 90 (ninety) working days.

### Eligibility:

- (a) M.Sc. Chemistry/Applied Chemistry/Chemic 1 Technology/ Agriculture Chemistry/Environmental Chemistry.
- (b) Chemistry as one of the subjects in U.Sc. or B.Sc. Chemical Technology.

Minimum percentage required is in B.Sc./M.Sc.(Chemistry) of Jiwaji University or any other University/Deemed University/Institute ecognised by the University.

Admission to the course will be many strictly on the basis of regrit. The merit will be a cided by the admission committee either on the basis of aptitude test/group discussion and interview or ercentage of marks obtained in the qualifying examination. However, details will be finalised by the dipartment and approval of Vice-Chancellor will be taken and will be given in the prospectus.

English is the only medium of instruction and examination for this course.

In order to organism extra curricular ac ivities, the students of the course will have a chemical society.

The department will have a placement cell.

The department will have an Alumini Association in order to have interaction with those who have graduar d from this department.

Examination fee, admission fee and other fee will be in accordance with the decisions of the department/University for the said contact from time to time.

A student of this programme will not be possitted to take up any other course simultaneously. However, restriction shall not be applicable to the students of language, certificate course, computer classes or remedial class s.

#### Scheme of Examination

The examination of first semest r shall consist of four (04) theory papers of 100 marks can, out of which 70 marks shall a for university examina ion and 30 marks for internal as a sment. Two tests of 15 arks each and one make up test for each course will be I Id on the dates specified by the lead/Coordinator of the repartment/School of Studies. The arks of the tests will a counted as the award for internal assessment. Tutorials, practical tests, reports etc. me also be taken into account for internal assessment.

In first semester there will also be two practicals courses of 100 marks each, out of which '0 marks shall be for university examination and 30 marks for internal assessment.

The second memeriter will consists of four theory papers of 100 marks each, out of which 70 rocks shall be for university examination and 30 marks for internal assessment.

Second semester ::1 also consist of four weeks industrial training. The condidate will submit a project report followed by evaluation and viva. The tot I marks for the project report of viva is 200. Out of 200 marks, the training and report will comprise 150 mars and viva of 50

marks. An external examiner from University/Industry/ Institute will be called to evaluate and conduct the viva.

The candidate who has cleared all the papers of first semester but for led in one paper of seand semester can appear in the paper is an ex-student student; the next semester.

If a candidate fails in more that one paper he/she will be allowed to appear as an ex-student in the whole examination of that semester in which to/she thus failed. Such candidate (if passed in that extendination) will be entitled for addission as a regular student in the next semester, if an,

For such additional attempts the university shall charge additional examination fee as notified by the university time of time.

No candidate hall be allowed more han two attempts (including the riginal attempt) in a 1 sticular semester. If that candidate does not succeed in two attempts too, he/she will have to leave that course.

The result of the first semester shall be declared as pass/fail. The final result for the dipl ma will be declared after the second semester. The total of all the marks secured by the mandidates will be counter and division shall be awarded on the basis of the marks second as follows:

Fire division : 60% or above mark in aggregate

Second division : Less than 60% but 8% or more

in aggregate

Third division : Less than 48% but 10% or more

in aggregate.
