(2 Years)

RULES OF ADMISSION FOR M.P.E. SUMMER COURSE (2 Years)

GENERAL RULES :

The candidates should have atleast 2 years of experience in the professional field after passing the B.P.E./B.P.Ed/ Diploma examinations. This experience may include teaching in a school, Centre or university, holding administrative or supervisory post in physical Education or Sports in educational institutions or other agencies. The candidates should be in service at the time of registration and their applications should be forwarded by the employing authority provided further that those teachers of physical Education who first took a certificate and then a degree or diploma in Physical Education of atleast one year duration, should have a minimum experience of eight years including atleast two year's experience after obtaining the degree of postgraduate diploma in Physical Education. Total seats shall be (60) sixty only. Admission will be granted on the basis of performance in the admission test to be held at the centre in the month of January. Minimum qualifying marks will be 40% and in the cases of SC/ST candidates the qualifying marks will be 35%.

COURSES OF STUDIES AND EXAMINATIONS :

Candidates admitted to this course shall attend the summer course of 10 weeks duration in each of the two years, besides self study under the guidance of the centre. Attendance requirement for Summer Course student will be 90% of the total number of sessions. There shall be final examination at the end of each year and promotion to the next higher class will be made on passing the examination of the preceeding year. The attendance will be calculated separately for the each subject and each activity/practical sessions.

The examination for M.P.E. Summer Course shall consist of eight written papers. Two papers shall be offered in the first year three in second years and three in the third years. Besides the university examination, sessional grades shall be added to each paper separately. A candidate must obtain for passing at least 45% marks in each written paper in the final examination and also obtain at least 45% marks aggregate in each paper including sessional marks in each year. No minimum pass percentage is prescribed in the sessional grades. In part II (Sports Specialisation) in M.P.E. (S.C.) II the candidates must obtain 45% marks. There shall be final examination in

Part II : Sports Specialization : Grand total : 100.

Besides the marks of final examination, professional marks will be added to the total of marks and also for sports specialization. A candidate must pass in each theory paper and sports-specialization separately. A candidate should complete the requirements for obtaining the degree within six years from the date of his first admission. Besides theory classes, candidate shall attend activity classes also.

The final examination in Thesis for third year shall consist of the evaluation of the thesis by two (one external and one internal) examiners, who shall value the thesis out of a maximum of 50 marks each. There shall be vivavoce examination in the thesis of a maximum of 50 marks.
