ORDINANCE NO. 65

Post Basic Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing)  
[Section ACC. 37 (ii) and 39 (i)]

GENERAL RULES :

(1) The degree shall be conferred after the completion of 1st Year and 11nd Year in theory and practical examination.

(2) The first examination shall be conducted as a Part-I after one year. At the end of the first year if the candidate fails in three papers he will get supplementary as well as he can appear in failing subjects alongwith Part-II examination after the completion of 11nd Year. His result of 11nd year will be detained till he has not completed all the failed paper of the first year.

(3) Eligibility : A candidate for the above degree must be a holder of General Nursing Diploma and two years experience in clinical field.

(4) Experience : The candidate should be registered with the state Registration Council of Nursing.

The candidate before the admission shall be examined by medical officer authorized by the principal for the purpose. The admission shall be granted only when the candidate is found medically fit to undergo their academic course and does not suffer from any disability or any contagious disease.

Criteria for the selection of the candidate : The candidate for the admission for the Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course shall have to be appear in written examination ordinarily held in the month of June/July and followed by a personal interview as per the merit of written examination and performance of the interview.

The candidate selected for the admission on the basis of written test and interview shall have to apply for registration to the registrar, [University] alongwith prescribed fee and eligibility certificate whenever applicable for- [University] candidate will be admitted to [University] course subject to the provision ordinance No. 65 of this [University].

A candidate after obtaining a General Nursing Diploma recognized by Council and who have done regular course of study in any School of Nursing affiliated by State Council or Indian Nursing Council shall be admitted to Part-I of Post Basic B.Sc. (N).

A candidate after passing Part-I of Post Basic B.Sc. & complete the regular course of study of one year in school of Nursing shall be affiliated to this University and such candidate shall be admitted to Post Basic B.Sc. (N) Part-II examination.

The general condition pertaining to the attendance, assignment and Internal evaluation of practical shall be as per the provision laid down ordinance No. 6 of this University provided that the division and qualifying mark in each paper shall be as per the scheme of examination.

The qualifying marks of each paper shall be 50% and 1st class shall be 60% in aggregate and 75% will be counted as an distinction in any of paper.

In addition of to Internal assessment practical, theory examination the candidate shall be required to submit all the assignment before commencing of the final examination.

The medium of instruction shall be in english.

The syllabus of the course and speciality shall be prescribed by the board of studies.
