ORDINANCE NO. 25

BACHELOR OF HOME SCIENCE

(Sec. 37(ii) and 39(i))

- (i) The examination for the degree of Bachelor of Home Science shall consist of Part I. Part II, and Part III (Final).
- (ii) The courses for each of the Fart I. II and III examination shall extend over a period of the academic year.
- (i) A candidate who after passing Higher Secondary examination or Intermediate examination under 10+2 pattern of M.P. Board of Secondary Education with Science or Home Science Group or any other examination recognised by the University or M.P. Board of Secondary Education as equivalent there to, shall be admitted to the B.H.Sc. Part I examination.
- (ii) A candidate after passing B.H.Sc. Part I shall be admitted to part II examination.
- (iii)A candidate after passing B.H.Sc. Part II Examination of this University shall be admitted to B.H.Sc. Part III also called as B.H.Sc. Final Examination.

There shall be a University examination at the end of each part ordinarily in March/April in each year. The candidate shall have to pass separately in each part in theory and practical paper then she can be deemed to be qualified for obtaining B.H.Sc. degree.

- (i) There shall be a supplementary examination ordinarily in August/Sept. each year in theory and practical.
- (ii) The following shall be eligible to appear in supplementary examination.
- (a) A candidate who has failed in one subject or paper as the case may be or in practical examination.

A candidate who was admitted to an examination as a regular candidate and was not declared successful there at or was not eligible to appear in examination though the admission not eligible to appear in examination by the University card was correctly issued to him/her by the University shall appear in the said examination as an ex-student.

The candidate will have to pass separately in each theory and practical examination separately in each or the Part I, Part II and Part III examination.

No division shall be assigned on the results of Part I, & II examination. The marks of Part I, II and III shall be

counted together for determining the result of Part III examination in which division shall be assigned on the following basis:

First Division Second Division Third Division

60 % and above 45 % and above 33 % and above.
