

ORDINANCE NO. 54

POST-GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN CLINICAL PATHOLOGY  
AND DIAGNOSTIC TECHNOLOGY

(1) The course for the P.G. Diploma will be divided into two semesters covering one academic session only. Each semester normally comprise 90 (ninety) working days.

(2) Eligibility :

B.Sc. with Biological subjects/Biochemistry/B.Pharma/  
B.H.Sc./Bachelor degree with any other subject of Life  
sciences.

The eligibility can be changed by the department depending on the nature of the Diploma offered. It will be published in the prospectus accordingly.

Minimum percentage required is 50% of Jiwaji University or any other University/Deemed University/Institute recognised by the University.

Admission to the course will be given to the candidates strictly on merit. The merit will be prepared after an aptitude test followed by group discussion and personal interview. The details will be finalised by the department, approval of Vice-Chancellor taken and published every year in the prospectus. Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from any University other than Jiwaji University will be required to obtain an eligibility certificate from the Registrar, Jiwaji University, Gwalior immediately after their provisional admission failing to which their admission will liable to be cancelled and the fee will not be refunded.

(3) English language will remain as medium of instruction and examination for this course.

In order to organize extracurricular activities, the students of the course will have a Clinical Pathology Association.

The department will have a placement cell.

The department will have an Alumni Association in order to have interaction with those who have graduated from this department.

Examination fee, admission fee and other fee will be in accordance with the decision of the department/university for the said course from time to time.

A student undertaking this course will not be allowed to take up any other course simultaneously. However, restriction shall not be applicable to the students of language, certificate course, computer classes or remedial classes.

#### Scheme of Examination :

The examination of first semester shall consist of Two (2) theory papers and two practical papers of 100 marks each of which 70 marks shall be for University Examination and 30 marks for internal assessment. Two tests of 15 marks each one of which may be a seminar and one make up test for each course shall be held on the dates specified by the Head/Coordinator of the department/School of Studies. The marks of the tests will be counted as the award of internal assessment.

The second semester will also consist of two (2) theory papers and two (2) practical papers of 100 marks each of which 70 marks shall be for University examination and 30 marks for internal assessment. The internal assessment will be made as in first semester

First and second semesters will consist training at the department and/or in hospitals. For practical examination, an external examiner will be called who will conduct the examination at Jiwaji University or at any hospitals/Medical Institution or at both places.

A candidate failing in to a maximum of any one paper of first semester examination shall be allowed to continue in the second semester. In the second semester the candidate has to appear in the paper of first semester (in which he/she has failed).

The candidate who has cleared all the papers of first semester but failed in one paper of second semester can appear in that paper as an ex-student in the next semester.

For such additional attempts the University shall charge additional examination fee as notified by the University time to time.

No candidate shall be allowed more than one attempt in a particular semester. If that candidate does not succeed in that attempt too, he/she will have to leave that course.

The result of the first semester shall be declared as pass/fail. The final result for the degree will be declared after the second semester. The sum total of all the marks secured by the candidates will be counted and division shall be awarded on the basis of the marks secured, as follows :

First division	:	60% or above marks in aggregate.
Second division	:	Less than 60% but not less than 48% in aggregate.
Third division	:	Less than 48% but not less than 40% in aggregate.

This ordinance will be applicable to Post Graduate Diploma in Clinical Pathology and Diagnostic Technology, Jiwaji University, Gwalior.

The total number of seats in the course is 30

The Fee for the course is Rs.5000.00 per semester
