

M.SC ( COMPUTER SCIENCE ) ORDINANCE

DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME :

The M.Sc (Computer Science) Programme of the university of two years duration and consists of four semesters - two semesters in the first year and the remaining two semesters in second year of the programme.

INTAKE :

The total number of seats at present is twenty.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

ELIGIBILITY :

The minimum qualifications for admission to the first semester of the course shall be :

B.Sc (Mathematics/Statistics/Computer Science/Electronics) with a degree recognized by the Jiwaji University, Gwalior, provided they have secured at least 50 percent marks in the aggregate.

SELECTION PROCEDURE :

The admission to this course will be finalized strictly on the merit basis in entrance test. The candidates securing the first twenty positions in the entrance test will be admitted to the course.

All eligible candidates will be called for written test. The test will consist of the following :

All questions will be of objective nature. The medium of test will be English only. The qualifying marks for written test will be 40 per cent in aggregate and 20 percent in each part separately.

FOREIGN STUDENTS :

No Foreign students will be admitted to this course without qualifying the written test. All such foreign students are residing in India and are studying in Indian universities are allowed to appear in the written test provided they fulfill the qualifications and conditions laid down for admission and

submit the letter of recommendation from Ministry of Human Resources Development and Ministry of External Affairs. Knowledge of B.A. standard English is essential for all foreign students. Fees structure for foreign students will be announced later.

#### 6. RESTRICTION ON M.Sc (Computer Science) STUDENTS :

A student of this course shall not be permitted to take up any other examination or course simultaneously. However this restriction shall not be applicable to the students of Language Certificate courses.

M.Sc (Computer Science) is a full time programme. Hence, no person can join a service during the tenure of course. If any such case comes to notice even at a later stage, his admission may be cancelled by the university.

#### 7. METHOD OF INSTRUCTIONS :

Regular scheduled classes for six days in a week along with practicals will be held as notified by the Head, School of Mathematics And Allied Sciences.

#### 8. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION AND EXAMINATION :

English is the only medium of instruction and examination for this course.

#### 9. ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS :

Each student will have to complete the minimum attendance requirement for appearing in the semester examination. His or her name will not be forwarded by the school if he or she fails to get a minimum of 75 percent attendance in each course.

#### SCHEME OF ASSESSMENT

The programme is based on continuous internal assessment as well as external examinations. The scheme of internal assessment is as follows :

#### MARKS OF SESSIONALS :

The sessional marks for internal assessment will be finalised by the teacher concerned. The sessional marks shall be based on :

A candidate is required to secure a minimum of 40% marks in individual courses in order to pass the internal assessment. The students must be very punctual and attentive in tests as there is no provision for make-up tests on any ground.

#### MINIMUM PASS MARKS :

In order to pass the semester, an examinee shall have to secure a minimum of 40% marks in individual papers. He/She will also be required to obtain a minimum of 40% marks in sessionals separately. Besides securing 40% marks in each paper and sessional, the candidate will have to secure a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate.

#### DIVISION IN EXAMINATION :

A candidate having secured 60% marks or above will be awarded first division. Candidates securing 50% but less than 60% marks in aggregate will be placed in second division. There will be no third division in the programme.

#### SCHEME OF PROMOTION TO NEXT SEMESTER :

I. A candidate failing maximum in two of the courses in first semester shall be allowed to continue in the second semester but he/she shall have to clear these courses alongwith the second semester examination. If he/she again fails in those courses (in which he/she had failed in the first semester), he/she shall be treated as an ex-student and shall appear in the subsequent examination.

II. If a candidate fails in three or more courses in first semester then he/she shall have to reappear in all the courses of subsequent first semester examination as an ex-student.

III. A candidate failing maximum in two of the courses in second semester shall be allowed to continue in the third semester provided he/she has cleared all the courses of the first semester. He/She shall have to clear those courses (in which he/she failed in the second semester) alongwith the third semester examination. If he/she again fails in those courses (in which he/she has failed in the first semester) he/she shall be treated as an ex-student and shall appear in the subsequent examination.

IV. If a candidate fails in three or more courses in second semester but has cleared all courses of the first semester then he/she will have to reappear in all the courses of subsequent second semester examination as an ex-student.

- V. The same criteria holds for third semester exam, as given in item III and IV for second semester examination.
- VI. If a student fails in project examination ( IVth semester) he/she will be allowed to resubmit the project thesis on or before the commencement of subsequent semester examination of each semester. If the candidate fails in any paper or papers in the fourth semester he/she will be allowed to appear again as an ex-student in the subsequent semester examination.
2. A candidate shall be given maximum two chances as an ex-student to clear the M.Sc (Computer Science) examination of each semester.
3. An examinee who has failed in internal examination shall be required to register himself fresh for doing the sessional work in the School of Mathematics And Allied Sciences in the subject in which he or she failed on payment of a fresh sessional fee of Rs. 50/- for each subject of sessional examination.

**IMPORTANT :**

1. The student will have to submit their project before the commencement of the fourth semester examination.
2. The dissertation will carry 50 marks and it will be evaluated by an external examiner. The same examiner will conduct the viva with the internal examiner.
3. Each student will have to attend an educational tour to be conducted by the department. The tour will include visit to international/national institute, organizations of repute located in India. Students will have to submit a tour report within a week after finishing the tour which will be evaluated by an internal examiner.
4. Out of the different optional papers, which are offered by the School, students shall be allowed to opt only those areas and courses for which facilities exist in the School.
5. The school can make any change in the scheme, particularly in respect to the courses prescribed, in order to adapt it to the rapidly changing know-how on one hand and keep in view of the requirements of the jobs being created in different areas, on the other.
6. Reservation of seats will be as per the M.P. Government rules.

Minimum Qualification and Admission Criteria :-

Admission requirements and procedure for admission in Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery course after intermediate at Vasundhara Raje Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital Gwalior shall be follows :

(1) Eligibility Rules :-

1.1. The applicant must be intermediate (with physics, Chemistry and Biology) of M.P. Board or any other board
