# ORDINANCE FOR THE MASTER OF RURAL MANAGEMENT ( M.R.M.)

## TWO YEARS (FOUR SEMESTERS) FULL TIME PROGRAMME

pe ordinance provides for admission, examination and other incidental matters relating to the Master of Rural Management, yo years (Four Semesters) Full time programme spread over four semesters; two semesters in the first year and two semesters in the second year.

#### DMISSION :

A candidate seeking admission to the first semester of the course shall be required to:

Possess a Bachelor's or a Master Degree in any discipline ith atleast second division (at least 49% marks in aggregate). or elaxation can be granted in 45% marks in aggregate except to hose who belong to SC/ST/OBC they will be given a relaxation of warks in the minimum of their qualifying examination. Their cats will be reserved as per M.P. Govt. rules.

The Candidates who are in service willing to join this ourse, will have to produce a no-objection certificate with two case leave from his/her employer. In case he/she fails to produce it same latest at the time of Interview, his/her candidature will be considered.

Admission to first semester shall be made on the basis of admission process consisting of ad Written test and personality Carrying a total weightage of 100 marks. The detailed rules lection procedure through the written test and personality will be framed and notified by the M.R.M. Admission Committee School of Studies in Rural Management year to year.

An applicant for the M.R.M. examination prosecuting a Fullourse of study leading to the Master of Rural Management bot be permitted to take up any other examination or course, meously.

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No person shall be admination or any equivalent examination already passed M.R.M. examination or any equivalent examination all university or statutory body. However, this restriction shall any university or piploma holders.

The candidate who has passed any part of M.R.M. Programme of university or Institution will not be admitted to M.R.M. Programme of this university on migration basis.

Each candidate will have to complete the minimum 75% attendance neach semester.

Each candidate will have to go for field work and submit a leld work report relating to any rural area/organisation after he second semester. This report will have to be submitted by him/her in third semester for valuation.

In IV Semester, each candidate will have to carryout a Project work on any topic approved by Faculty council of the department of Rural Management and submit his Project Report for valuation atleast Rural Management the commencement of IVth Semester examination.

#### EXAMINATION :

- (1) Subject to the provisions of this ordinance, the scheme of examination and the syllabus and text books, will be prescribed crarecommended in connection with any subject for any of the examination covered by this ordinance and the conditions on which he students shall be admitted to such examination, shall be in accordance with the provision; made by the Academic Council after accordance with the provision; made by the Academic Council after accordance to the recommendations of concerned Board of Studies and the Faculty of Management.
  - Each examination shall be regarded as a separate unit for the purpose of working out the result of the candidate. For the purpose of calculation of the individual courses/papers, the score in internal assessment and in the university examination will be counted together.

A student will be promoted to the next semester only after ing passed atleast four papers of current semester out of total alx (6) papers. In the remaining two (2) papers he/she can appear again with the ensuing concerning semester examination as appear. This is to be done by him/her in the two subsequent mester examinations.

A candidate will be allowed only two additional attemps than the original attempt) to pass any course. If somebody to do so he/she may in the appear as an entire examinations the concerned semester as an ex-student.

The medium of instruction and examination for this programme hall be English/Hindi.

- (1) Candidate appearing in any semester exams as an exstudent shall be examined in accordance with the existing scheme and syllabi in force at that time.
- (di) Candidate shall be entitled to the award of the degree of the year in which all the courses are cleared by him/her.

Division shall be wa awarded on the following basis:

Pass

- 75% marks or above in aggregate.

- 60% and above in aggregate.

- 48% and above but below 60% in aggregate.

- 40% and above but below 48% in aggregate.

A student of M.R.M. (Any Semester) will be entitled to the benefit of Vice Chancellor's gratce of one marks for passing the examination of any semester or obtaining the next division if he loses the next division by only one mark in aggregate).

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the course structure, procedure of admission test will, be finalised by Head and Dean of M.R.M. Programme under the guidance of Board of Studies in Management, subject to the approval of faculty of Management and Hon'ble Vice Chancellor.
