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


The study Centre has formulated choice-based credit system in M.A.History as per ordinance 168 A for the academic session 2015-17. In this system, there are 80 valid credits and 16 virtual credits in the complete span of the course of two years. From these 80 credits, 48 credits should accrue from core subject, 16 credits from Elective Subject, 6 credits from seminar, 6 credits from Assignment and 2 credits from project-based work. Virtual credits are 16 which the student has to earn through comprehensive viva-voce held after every semester. Hence 4 virtual credits are given to each comprehensive viva-voce. Thus, the total credits for the entire course of study come to 96 credits. From these 96 credits, credits for each sub head are following:






